EXPLANATORY NOTES and TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. **DELEGATE REGISTRATION.** The delegate registration is for the **full conference registration**. This will entitle you to access all the conference events in the programme (unless otherwise indicated).
2. **CLOSING DATES FOR REGISTRATION.** Early-bird registration closes on **Tuesday 22 December 2009** (registering by this date will entitle you to the Early-bird discount). Final registrations close on **Friday 12 March 2010**.
3. **CONFERENCE COSTS.** Cost for the conference and related events are shown in the table below:

REG	Full registration —Friday to Sunday, excluding accommodation—all sessions including conference, dinner, meals, etc.	\$190.00 per delegate
EB	Early-bird registration —As per full registration but the registration form(s) and payment must be received by COB Tuesday 22 December 2009.	\$165.00 per delegate
REGC	Full registration—concession. This is a full registration, but at a concession rate, for RYLA, Rotaract, Exchange and other students.	\$110.00 per delegate
DIN	Dinner-only registration for delegates' partners (Saturday night dinner; includes a pre-dinner drink and wine with dinner)	\$75.00 per partner
FRI	Friday night presentation. This is for the Friday night presentation opening at Wrest Point and includes supper. This is only intended for non-delegates.	\$35.00 per non-delegate
NMB	New member breakfast (Saturday). This cost is in addition to the conference registration costs. It is intended for new members only. The home Clubs of the new members are invited to bear the costs for this breakfast.	\$25.00 per new member
PHB	Paul Harris Fellows Sunrise Breakfast (Sunday). This cost is in addition to the conference registration costs.	\$25.00 per PH Fellow
BUS	Bus Transport to/from Government House —Friday night, for the Government House Reception. This is in addition to the registration costs.	\$10.00 per delegate

4. **GOVERNMENT HOUSE RECEPTION.** The first **200 registered delegates** will be invited to a reception at Government House on **Friday Night 26 March 2010**, prior to the opening of the Conference.
5. **BUS TRANSPORT FOR GOVERNMENT HOUSE.** This is for those delegates who prefer to *not* use their own transport to Government House for the Friday night Reception. This is for pick-up from, and return to, Wrest Point Hotel. ***Please note that there is limited parking at Government House.***
6. **PARTNERS.** If a non-registered partner is accompanying a delegate to the Conference there are events for which you may register the partner individually, for example, the Saturday night dinner. Partners may only attend the events for which they have registered.
7. **RYLA, ROTARACT, EXCHANGE AND OTHER STUDENTS.** Sponsoring Clubs are invited to pay the registration cost for these students. If you are registering for a concession registration, you may wish to contact your Club before submitting your registration form.
8. **NEW MEMBER BREAKFAST.** Clubs are asked to encourage all New Members of 2009/10 to register for the Conference and are invited to 'sponsor' their participation at an exclusive 'New Members' Breakfast', 7.30 a.m., Saturday 27 March. New Members will have the opportunity to share their vision with a keynote speaker for the occasion and report back to Clubs.
9. **PAUL HARRIS FELLOWS SUNRISE BREAKFAST.** This will be held on **Sunday morning**.
10. **ACCOMMODATION.** If you need accommodation for the Conference, Wrest Point has made a number of packages available from which you may select. You will need to book these packages ***directly with Wrest Point*** on the enclosed '**Wrest Point Hotel—Accommodation Booking Form**' with the Reference Number: **184359**. ***Please use this form as it is pre-coded for the Rotary 2010 Conference.*** Using other booking methods will prevent you from getting the Conference discounted packages.
