



## **BOWELSCAN NOTES FOR PHARMACIES**

- Please ensure that ALL staff are familiar with procedures for selling and receiving used bowel scan kits – see “**At A Glance**” notes on back of kit selling stands.
- Kits returned for testing **MUST** be collected in the bin provided, which is placed at a location in the store **WELL AWAY** from kits available for sale. Pharmacy staff should not handle used kits or accept used kits from customer – the customer should be instructed to place the used kit in the bin provided.
- A representative of the local Rotary club will collect kits for testing on a regular basis.
- The distribution of brochures is an important part of the program promotion, and is a major expense which is funded for Rotary by the program sponsors. **Please distribute ALL of these brochures** in bags or whatever means is available (e.g. customer accounts at the end of February). These brochures cannot be used after March 2011, so please don't let them be wasted.
- Note that kits **MUST NOT** be sold before **1<sup>st</sup> March** or after **31<sup>st</sup> March**. Kits sold outside these dates will not be tested within the required time limits.
- The plastic stands provided are for the sale of kits, not for the display of brochures. The **sale price per kit is \$8.00**. Most pharmacies setup a product code in their pharmacy point of sale systems. (Note price reduction from last year). Unfortunately the kits are not bar coded.
- Collection of the kits will begin on or around March 7<sup>th</sup>, and the final collection run will be on April 14<sup>th</sup>. Kits sold during March can be returned up until this date. Bins will remain in place until April 21<sup>st</sup> to allow for late returns.
